



## GOLF – CHRISTCHURCH TO CHRISTCHURCH

Day 1

Christchurch (L/D)

This morning you will be picked up from your hotel or the airport by luxury coach or limousine and travel north to **Hanmer Springs Golf Club**.

On arrival you will play a round of 18 holes on this championship course.

*Hanmer Springs Golf Club is located in one of New Zealand's most popular holiday and tourist centres. The 18-hole championship golf course is situated in a high country basin 385 metres above sea level.*

This afternoon you will enjoy the Waipara Wine Trail, making stops at several wineries for wine tasting.

You will then travel into Christchurch City where you will be taken directly to the **Millennium Hotel** for check in.

Later in the evening, you will be transferred from the **Heritage Hotel** to a local restaurant. Here you will enjoy a 3 course set menu style dinner, before being returned by luxury coach or limousine to your hotel.

**Accommodation: Millennium Hotel – Executive Suites (2 nights)**

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at your hotel restaurant.





You will then reboard your luxury coach or limousine and travel to **Terrace Downs High Country Golf Resort**.

Here you will play 18 holes on this par 72 championship course.

*Terrace Downs Golf Course was designed by Sid Pudicome & Associates in 1993 and officially opened in 2001. It offers a unique mixture of Parklands and links style with the underlying philosophy of the course development ensuring its integration into the natural environment and the respect and enjoyment of all who play on it. The views of the Rakaia Gorge and mountain vistas remain a constant challenge for players to keep their eye on the ball!*

You will then enjoy lunch at Terrace Down's Tilley's Bar & Brassiere.

This afternoon try your hand at one of the many optional activities on offer at Terrace Downs:

-  Blokarts
-  Archery
-  Jet Boating
-  Clay Pigeon shooting

You will then board your luxury coach or limousine and return to Christchurch.

This evening you will enjoy dinner in a local Christchurch restaurant.

**Accommodation: Millennium Hotel**

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at your hotel restaurant.

This morning you will travel the short distance to **Clearwater Golf Resort**.

On arrival, you will play a round of 18 holes on this par 72 championship course.

*Clearwater Golf Course is built around a series of man-made lakes, bringing water into play on 14 holes. The overall look of the course includes lakes, tussock and marram grass that, with neatly manicured bent grass fairways and greens, leave it looking uniquely like a cross between an Old World links and an American parkland course.*

After your game, enjoy a 2 course set menu style lunch in The Lakes Restaurant.

This afternoon you will reboard your luxury coach or limousine for a sightseeing tour that will include travel along the Banks Peninsula to Akaroa.

*In 1840, French settlers arrived at Akaroa, which had just been claimed under the Treaty of Waitangi by the English. To this day, Akaroa remains unique as the site of the only attempted settlement by the French in New Zealand. Many streets have French names, and there are descendants of the original French families still living in Akaroa. The charm of this old French town, together with the incredible scenery encountered on the way, have assured Akaroa's popularity as a unique tourist destination.*

This evening you will enjoy dinner in a local Akaroa restaurant.

You will then board your luxury coach or limousine and return to Christchurch.

On arrival into Christchurch, you will either be transferred to your hotel or to the airport.
