



GOLFERS DREAM – SOUTH ISLAND

“Kia Ora” and Welcome to New Zealand!

After Immigration and Customs formalities, you will be met by a Green Realm Travel representative, who will assist with your private transfer to your CBD hotel.

Christchurch, “The Garden City”, has many well-tended parks, reserves and squares but the civic love of beauty is often more apparent in the fresh lawns and burgeoning gardens of the suburban streets. The pioneering folk of an earlier era had a thought for the future when they planted seedlings which have grown into mighty oaks and elms, soaring poplars and graceful willows, now seen in every part of the city. Much of the charm of this city starts and finishes with the beautiful Avon River that runs through the suburbs and the city, providing an almost rural atmosphere in the heart of the city.

Day 1

Christchurch (B/L/D)

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

This morning you will board your luxury coach or limousine and travel the short distance to **Clearwater Golf Resort**.

On arrival, you will play a round of 18 holes on this par 72 championship course.

Clearwater Golf Course is built around a series of man-made lakes, bringing water into play on 14 holes. The overall look of the course includes lakes, tussock and marram grass that, with neatly manicured bent grass fairways and greens, leave it looking uniquely like a cross between an Old World links and an American parkland course.

After your game, enjoy a 2 course set menu style lunch in The Lakes Restaurant.

This afternoon you will enjoy your second round of golf.

You will then re-board your luxury coach or limousine and be transferred to your hotel.

Later in the evening, the group will be transferred by the Driver Guide from to a top **Christchurch restaurant**. Here you will enjoy a 3 course set menu style dinner.

Accommodation: Millennium Hotel (Executive Suite)

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

This morning you board your luxury coach or limousine and enjoy an incredibly scenic drive north to **Hanmer Springs Golf Club**.

On arrival you will play a round of 18 holes on this championship course.

Hanmer Springs Golf Club is located in one of New Zealand's most popular holiday and tourist centres. The 18-hole championship golf course is situated in a high country basin 385 metres above sea level. The Waipara Valley in north Canterbury, is Canterbury's premier wine-growing region, and is about 45 minutes' drive north of Christchurch. Waipara is one of the fastest growing wine producing regions in New Zealand, currently boasting over 40 vineyards and wineries.

After golf you will be served lunch in Hanmer at a well known local restaurant.

This afternoon you will enjoy the Waipara Wine Trail, making stops at several wineries for wine tasting followed by dinner at **Pegasus Bay vineyard**.

The Waipara Valley in north Canterbury, is Canterbury's premier wine-growing region, and is about 45 minutes' drive north of Christchurch. Waipara is one of the fastest growing wine producing regions in New Zealand, currently boasting over 40 vineyards and wineries.

You will then be transferred back to Christchurch and your hotel.

Accommodation: Millennium Hotel (Executive Suite)





Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

This morning you will then board your luxury coach or limousine and travel to **Terrace Downs High Country Golf Resort**. Here you will play 18 holes on this par 72 championship course.

Terrace Downs Golf Course offers a unique mixture of Parklands and links style with the underlying philosophy of the course development ensuring its integration into the natural environment and the respect and enjoyment of all who play on it. The views of the Rakaia Gorge and mountain vistas remain a constant challenge for players to keep their eye on the ball!

After your game, enjoy a 2 course set menu lunch in **Tilley's Bar and Brasserie**.

This afternoon try your hand at one of the many optional activities on offer at Terrace Downs:

-  Blokarts
-  Archery
-  Jet Boating
-  Clay Pigeon shooting

Dinner will be in Terrace Downs Avoca Fine Dining where you can enjoy an exceptional dining experience from the resorts award winning High Country Cuisine.

Accommodation: Terrace Downs (Villa suite)

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

You will then board your luxury coach or limousine and travel from **Terrace Downs High Country Golf Resort** for your journey to Queenstown via Mt Cook. This inland route winds through some of the most evocative hill country to be found in New Zealand, with the forever-present Southern Alps splitting the South Island distinctly into west and east.

Your journey takes you through the centre of the picturesque South Island with highlights such as Lake Tekapo, a turquoise glacial lake. A stop is made at the lake's edge to look at the simple stone Church of the Good Shepherd and the nearby bronze sheep dog. Further south you will pass Lake Pukaki before following the shoreline to Mt Cook Village.

On arrival at Mt Cook you will be taken to the **Hermitage Hotel** for a 3 course set luncheon in the Alpine Restaurant. Following lunch you will enjoy an up close and personal encounter with icebergs through an amazing unique guided tour and boat excursion on the Tasman Glacier lakes. Following this unforgettable experience, you will visit the Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre – Museum and Planetarium where you will gain an appreciation of the unique history of the Aoraki / Mt Cook area.

This evening you will enjoy a dinner at the hotel's Panorama Restaurant before retiring to spectacular views of Mt Cook from your top floor room.

Accommodation: The Hermitage (Aoraki Wing)

After breakfast you will board your luxury coach or limousine and journey south across the Mackenzie Country. Crossing the Lindis Pass, which links the Mackenzie Country with Central Otago, you will follow the Kawarau River to the township of Cromwell before entering the Kawarau Gorge and arriving into the Wakatipu Valley, home of Arrowtown and Queenstown.

On arrival into Queenstown you will be transferred to **Millbrook Golf Resort** where you will check in to your accommodation.

Following a 2 course set luncheon in the Clubhouse Restaurant you will play a round of 18 holes on this par 72 championship course.

Millbrook, designed by Sir Bob Charles, is without question one of the finest alpine golf courses in the world. It's a 6412 metre, par-72 that is relatively wide open and trouble free for golfers of all handicaps. It's not the awesome challenge of the course that attracts players so much as its awesome setting. Nowhere else in New Zealand can you play golf with a mountain range like The Remarkables as a backdrop.

This evening you will enjoy a 3 course set menu dinner at **The Millhouse**.

Accommodation: Millbrook Golf Resort (Hotel Villa)

Day 6

Queenstown (B/L/D)

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

This morning you will play your 2nd round of 18 holes on this par 72 championship course.

Later, enjoy a 2 course set menu style lunch in the Clubhouse Restaurant.

This evening you will travel to **Gibbston Valley Wines** where you will enjoy wine tasting.

You will then reboard your luxury coach or limousine and travel into Queenstown where you will check into your accommodation for the night, the **Sofitel Hotel**.

This evening dinner will be at a well known restaurant on The Steamer Wharf at Queenstown.

After dinner the night is yours to enjoy vibrant Queenstown.

Accommodation: Sofitel Hotel (Deluxe Lake View room)






Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

This morning you will board your luxury coach or limousine and travel to **Jacks Point**.

The 18 hole 72-par golf course designed by John Darby and Brett Thomson, of Darby Partners. The course is bounded by the Remarkables mountain range and Lake Wakatipu. It traverses through wetland to the lake edge encountering steep bluffs, indigenous vegetation and wildlife. It is designed to work with nature, not against it. Fairways are designed with minimal excavation and careful plantings to complement the natural environment, but also to give the golfer a fighting chance.

After your round of golf you will re-board your luxury coach or limousine and be transferred to the **Amisfield Wine Company** for wine tasting and a sumptuous lunch.

You will then board your luxury coach or limousine and travel back to Queenstown where the afternoon is open for you to experience some of the many optional activities and attractions in the region:

-  Dart River Safari Excursion including light BBQ Lunch
-  ½ day Skippers Canyon adventure by 4WD
-  Shotover Jet Boat Ride
-  TSS Earnslaw Cruise & BBQ Lunch at Walter Peak Station
-  The world famous AJ Hackett Bungy Jump

The evening is free for you to explore the many restaurants and cafes of Queenstown.

Accommodation: Sofitel Hotel (Deluxe Lake View room)

Day 8

Queenstown –Milford (B/L/D)

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

A very memorable day! You will depart Queenstown on your luxury coach or limousine for a day of unsurpassed scenery as you travel into a World Heritage area. During your journey, there is time for photo stops and short walks along the way.

On arrival, you will embark on your overnight cruise aboard the "Milford Mariner" to enjoy a leisurely, extended full-length cruise of Milford Sound, including the hidden mouth of the Sound, towering Mitre Peak, cascading Stirling Falls, and wildlife viewing. Dinner on the Milford Mariner is a 3 course buffet.

Accommodation: Milford Mariner (Private ensuite cabin)

This morning you will enjoy a cooked/continental while cruising back into Milford jetty.

At the end of the cruise, you will be transferred to the Milford Air strip; here you will board a fixed wing aircraft to fly to Queenstown. The flight will be one of the most memorable of your lives as you look down on suspended lakes, the fiords and world famous Milford Track. On arrival into Queenstown airport, you will be transferred by luxury sedan cars to your hotel.

The remainder of the day is yours to relax and reflect or further enjoy the many optional attractions and activities of Queenstown.

In the early evening, the group will meet at a private spot in the **Sofitel Hotel**. Here a representative from one of the well-known wineries will greet you. With the guidance of your winery host, you will have the opportunity to sample 3 or 4 of their Pinot wines, and some of the cheese they make onsite at the winery. Canapés that have been created using some of the local produce will be served, and the chef from the hotel restaurant will meet with the group and briefly explain the different canapés that are being served to you that evening.

After the wine tasting and canapés the group will stroll a short distance to a well known local restaurant, for you final night's meal.

Day 10

Queenstown (B)

Upon waking you have the choice of a full continental or cooked breakfast at the hotel restaurant.

You will be transferred from your hotel to Queenstown Airport, by private transfer.
